advice for having a good ride...
...and not getting arrested

- Riders in the front—keep to a pace that allows the whole ride to stay together.
- Riders in the back—pay attention; don't let the ride get away from you.
- The police often break the law and give false information. Do not take their flyers.
- One can get arrested at any time for any or no reason.
- Cops often grab whoever is nearby first, so try to keep beyond arms reach of any cop, paddy wagon, scooter, horse, net, or other police conveyance or device.
- It's good for a few people to do reconnaissance during the ride: check ahead, behind and on blocks parallel to the group.
